2B threw to the 1B (Fred Merkle) to retire the batter, John Hummel (OUT 2)

The runner from second, Al Burch, had rounded third and the 1B threw across the diamond to the 3B (Art Devlin) and King Arthur relayed to the C (Chief Meyers) who tagged Burch at the plate (OUT 3)

Since both runners were off on the pitch, it was easy work for the 1B to hike back to first and touch first bag before the runner from first, Willis Cole, could get back (OUT 2)

1B throws over to the SS (Donie Bush) who steps on the bag at second to nail the runner caught off that sack, Patsy Dougherty, before he could reclaim the base (OUT 3)

Frank Chance (CHN) is the batter with a 0-0 count who gave the sign he intended hitting the first pitch, which he sent whistling high over second base. The SS (Arnold Hauser) jumped sideways into the air and made a one-handed catch (OUT 1)

SS came down on the bag, automatically doubling up the runner caught off second, Jimmy Sheckard (OUT 2)

SS, could have made an unassisted TP because the runner from first, Solly Hofman, was within reach, but the SS played it safe and tossed to the 1B (Ed Konetchy) who retired Hofman (OUT 3)

The runner from third, Red Murray, was half way home and the 2B started to complete the play, but Murray raced back toward third and the 2B was compelled to toss the ball to the 3B (Heinie Zimmerman) to retire the runner (OUT 3)

The runner at second, Mickey Corcoran, was afraid to go to third and the runner from first, Harry Gaspar, was forced to turn around and hike back to first. The C's relay to the 1B (Jimmy Archer) beat him there and he was tagged (OUT 3)
