Charlie Grimm (CHN) is the batter with a 0-0 count. He hits a grounder to the 2B (Hod Ford). The runner at third, Hack Wilson, trapped between third and home, was tagged by the C (Clyde Sukeforth) after a relay from 2B to the 3B (Tony Cuccinello) (OUT 1)  
 Meanwhile the runner from first, Danny Taylor, had stopped at second and the batter, Charlie Grimm, was bearing down on the bag, so the C ran through the diamond and tossed to the 1B (Joe Stripp) who tagged the batter returning to first on a slide (OUT 2)  
 Now the runner from first, Danny Taylor who had stopped at second, rushed toward third but the 1B throw to the 3B nailed him (OUT 3)
